

Cookies policy

What are cookies?

“Cookies” are small text files stored locally on the hard drive of your computer. They are there to keep available information for retrieval at a later time, in order to facilitate the use of our online services. When your visit is over and you close the browser, cookies you were using are deleted automatically.

During your visit to our website, if you have accepted cookies, you will automatically download these files to your device. The cookies we use do not store personally identifiable information.

What do we use cookies for?

We use cookies to offer you a better browsing experience, analysing the data, measuring how many people are using the services we provide, monitoring and improving our services.

We may also use cookies regarding social media integration on our website, such as for buttons allowing you to share our site on Facebook.

We do not record your personal information and would never pass your data to third party.

How to control and delete cookies

You may prefer to disable cookies on this site and on others. The most effective way to do this is to disable cookies in your browser, however, should you choose to disable or block our cookies, some parts of our website will not function fully, or in some cases, our website will not be accessible at all.
